The County is developing ideas that could develop into PILOT projects in hopes of finding solutions that meet each community's unique needs as ambulance service is a problem throughout the County.

- A Certificate of Insurance is needed to accompany per this agreement.

RESOLUTION 2022-102: Town Council Approval of Agreement with Madison County for Snow & Ice Control on the County Road System

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Madison County adopted **Resolution**No. <u>22-402</u> on <u>September 13, 2022</u> designating the improved roads of the County Road System of the County upon which snow and ice removal should be performed; and

WHEREAS, the County Superintendent of Highways was authorized to enter into agreements with the Town for the aforementioned purpose starting <u>October 1</u>, <u>2022 through April 30, 2023</u> at rates as specified in the Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of <u>Hamilton</u>, Madison County be and hereby is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the County of Madison to perform snow and ice removal upon the improved County Road System as per attached Agreement.
