REGISTRAR of VITAL STATISTICS: We had a transgendered couple come here to get a marriage license because they were denied a license by a Clerk in neighboring town where they lived.

RABIES CLINIC: Carol Lawrence, DCO, organized a very successful rabies clinic in Sherburne on Saturday, May 4, where over 71 dogs and cats received shots. Kelly Small and I volunteered and handled filling out the rabies certificate for the veterinarian. Several Hamilton residents were able to get their rabies shots for their dogs to license at the Town.

FAX: Having trouble with Esker fax service on the receiving end. Ticket request sent to MCIT. They are still working on it.

WHITELIST TOWN EMAILS: Due to issues for both incoming and outgoing emails being blocked for security reasons, I worked with ACC Tech to create a Whitelist of approved emails to help avoid this issue. The emails included are Planning and Zoning Board members and other staff as well as our attorneys, insurance vendor, etc. Also, any email from Madison County, Village of Hamilton, and Colgate. The list will need to be added to and updated as needed. Anyone having trouble reaching an email can send a request to me to have that email added on.

## DECALS (HUNTING & FISHING LICENSES) CHANGES FOR 2024:

The DEC is eliminating the specialized printer and Valeron paper that everyone has been using for the last 10+ years and moving to printing on plain white paper. This does increase the costs for the towns, but they are working with NYS legislation to allow a \$1.00 fee to the town for any license (3 pages) that needs to be printed in house. Not all of them will need to be printed as some only want it emailed to them. Additionally, they are cutting back on distribution of the Hunting and Fishing books and are readily found on their website.

COMMUNITY BIKES: Community Bikes does not have water in their new building (old basket factory), so I have given them permission to use the town's hose and water at the back of the building to wash their bikes when needed.

POOLVILLE CEMETERY RECORDS: Rae Davey reached out to let me know that Janelle Ayers was named Secretary for the Cemetery. On April 30, Bob Tackabury picked up most of the documents left behind in January apart from a few archives which are in a Fire Safe per Bob's request.

MADISON COUNTY MUNICIPAL CLERKS ASSOCIATION (MCMCA): MCMCA held a meeting on April 30. While it was only a small group, we had a productive conversation on a variety of topics such as dogs, handicap placards, tax collection, FOIL requests, 1st amendment audits and the changes in election.

CHANGES IN ELECTION: NYS enacted Chapter 7431 of the Laws of 2023 which goes into effect January 1, 2025. I reviewed the elected positions and made a quick spreadsheet to show its impact.

Changes due to recently enacted Chapter 741 of the Laws of 2023; goes into effect on January 1, 2025.

An office with a 4 year-term to be elected in 2025 will be elected for a 3-year term ending in 2028.

An office with a 4 year-term to be elected in 2027 will be elected for a 3-year term ending in 2030.
